"New London School Explosion", New London, TX - March 18th, 1937

- At least 295 fatalities
- 3rd worst disaster in Texas history

"Great New Orleans Fire", New Orleans, LA - March 21st, 1788

- The fire destroyed 856 of the 1,100 structures in the city of New Orleans.
- 3 ships were sent to <u>Philadelphia</u> for provisions immediately after the fire.

"Triangle Shirtwaist Factory Fire", New York, NY - March 25th, 1911

- 146 fatalities
- Incident resulted in a call for reforms in fire safety and workplace safety.
