### **Significant November Fires Throughout U.S. History:**

Great Boston Fire - Boston, MA - November 9<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup>, 1872

- The fire left 85 dead and over 600 injured.
- It is believed that as many as 30 people were killed including 11 firefighters.

Coconut Grove Night Club - Boston, MA - November 20<sup>th</sup>, 1942

- 2<sup>nd</sup> deadliest single-building fire in US history. 492 people perished.
- Contributing factors: Overcrowding, combustible finishes, and locked doors.

MGM Grand Hotel and Casino - Las Vegas, NV - October 21st, 1980

- The fire left 85 dead and over 600 injured.
- Over 1000 people were rescued from the roof by helicopter.
